The more people who sign this petition, the greater the influence and impact it can have. As such, we have put together a quick guide with some pointers for gathering signatures.

Pointers for gathering signatures:

- Recruit friends, family and co-workers to sign the petition – and see if any of them are interested in gathering more signers.
- College campuses are often a great place to get a lot of signatures – try setting up a table outside of the student union or some other high-traffic location.
- Standing on the sidewalk (public property) of a busy area is also a good place to gather signatures.
- Don't be afraid to call people over – once you have their attention deliver a very brief speech explaining what the petition is and why they should sign it. People are often in a hurry, so keep it brief: 2-3 sentences are probably best.
- While a lot of people may only be interested in signing and moving on, some people will (hopefully!) be interested in doing more to help. Have more information available to give to people who express an interest in SGAC.
- If you can, have red ribbons available to hand out to people.
